- What is the Access Fee?

5€ daily for those (age over 14 years) who pay the Access Fee by the fourth last day before the day of access and 10€ daily for those (age over 14 years) who pay the Access Fee after the fourth last day before the day of access. The amount is unique, for a single person and there are no reductions.

The goal for the new fee is to encourage visitors to stay longer, reduce overcrowding and make Venice more hospitable for its permanent residents

The Venice Access Fee will be in place for the following dates for 2025:

• Every Day from April 18th to May 04th, 2025

- From May 9th to July 27th the fee applies on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays
- June 2nd (Republic Day)

• How to pay the Access Fee?

This tourist and entry tax to Venice will be payable on the dedicated website <u>https://cda.ve.it/en/</u> which will issue a QR code to be presented in the event of an inspection.

Therefore, there will be no counters, barriers or other turnstiles to control the tax. The checks will be carried out randomly in Venice by municipal agents.

• Who has to book a ticket to visit Venice?

Travellers planning on visiting the historic city of Venice will have to register their visit, although those staying the night do not have to pay the entry fee.

Visitors arriving by both public transport and private methods must pre-book.

- Visitors who arrive without booked and paid will have to pay the full €10 fee and are subject to fines from €50 to €300.
- Visitors are encouraged to book in advance as ticket prices could be lower.

Those visiting the surrounding islands such as Burano and Murano will also have to register and pay. Only one ticket and payment is required for those travelling to multiple islands, including Venice.

Some day trippers are exempt from paying the entry fee, although they will still have to book. These include residents of the Veneto region, students, and those visiting family members in the city.

The local council has previously emphasized that there will be no limit to visitor numbers, only an increase in the entry fee should a certain number of visitors be reached on a particular day.

• What will the entry fee go towards?

The fee is "not a tool for making cash," the city said in a statement.

Aside from the costs of running the system, any proceeds from the entry fees will go towards services that help the residents of the city. These include maintenance, cleaning and reducing living costs.

• Exemptions

With the Exception of the categories born and residents in the Municipality of Venice:

- Children under the age of 14
- Disability Card holders and their accompanying caregivers
- Members of the Armed Forces and the Police

People who fall into the Exempt category must compulsorily register without having to proceed with the payment.
